§ 79-7 Regulations.

The following regulations shall be observed by all licensees and their employees:

A.

No licensee or employee of a licensee shall do or perform or cause, suffer or permit any of the following acts:

(1)

Operate any power or manual lawn mower or other power equipment earlier than 8:00 a.m. nor later than 6:00 p.m. on weekdays or earlier than 9:00 a.m. nor later than 6:00 p.m. on Saturdays or legal holidays or at any time on Sundays; provided, however, that such equipment may be operated between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sundays and legal holidays if not more than one such piece of equipment is in use at any one time and such use is by a person who resides on the property where the equipment is being operated. This subsection shall not preclude the operation at any time of such equipment as may reasonably be required in case of emergency conditions.

(2)

Place any garbage, refuse, cuttings, leaves, wood or other materials upon any public highway, public place or private property.

(3)

Scatter any garbage, refuse, cuttings, leaves or other waste materials from the custody of such persons onto any public highway, public place or private property.

(4)

Park a commercial vehicle on a village street.

B.

The gardener's license shall be maintained by the licensee or his designee and displayed on the jobsite.
